Our Purpose

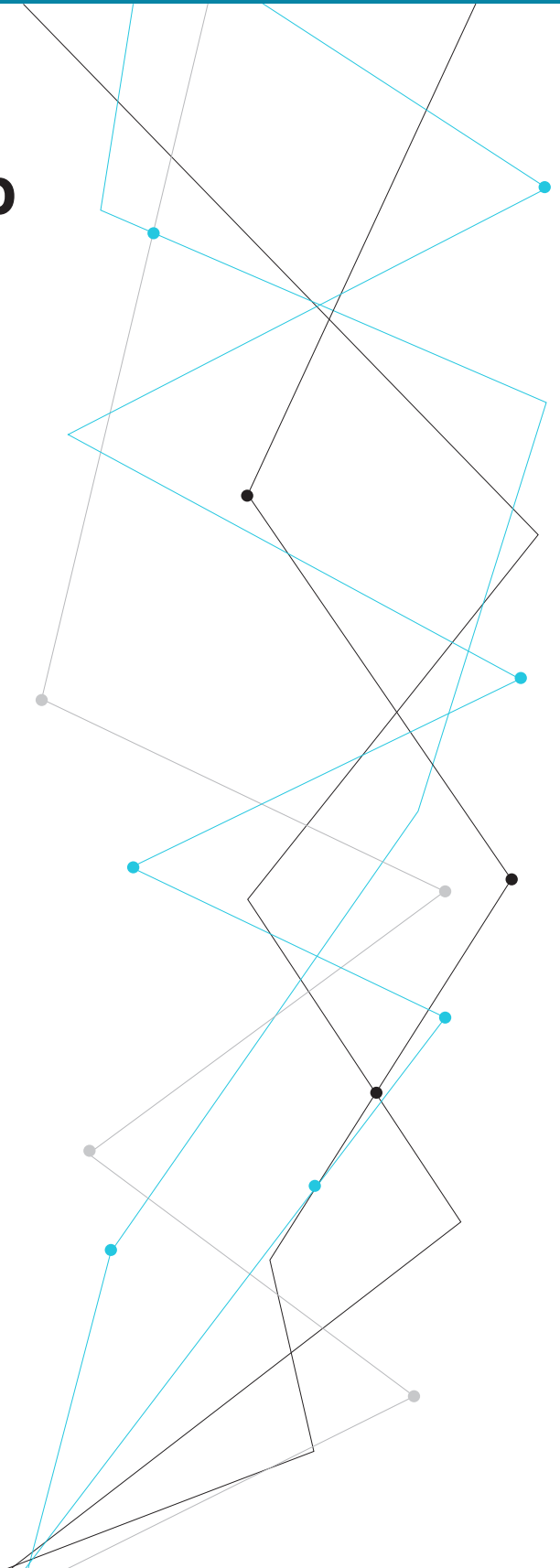
